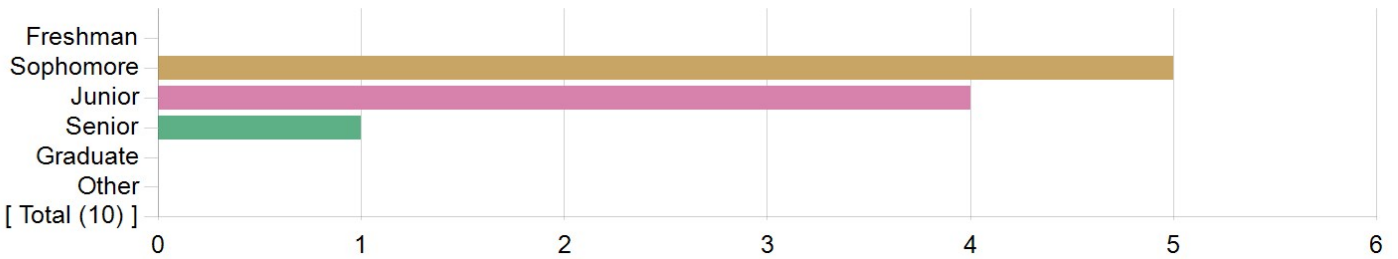

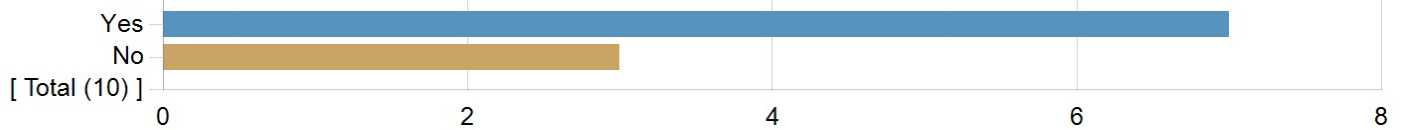

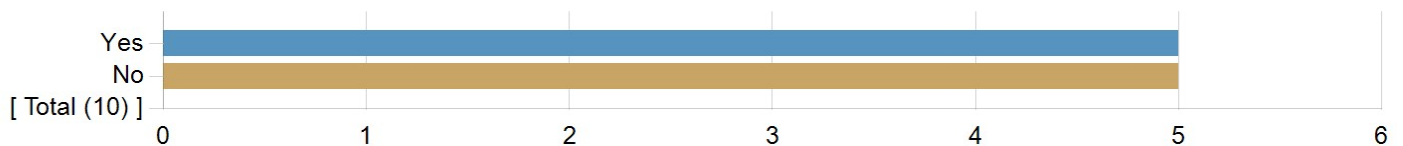

Is this course in your major field?



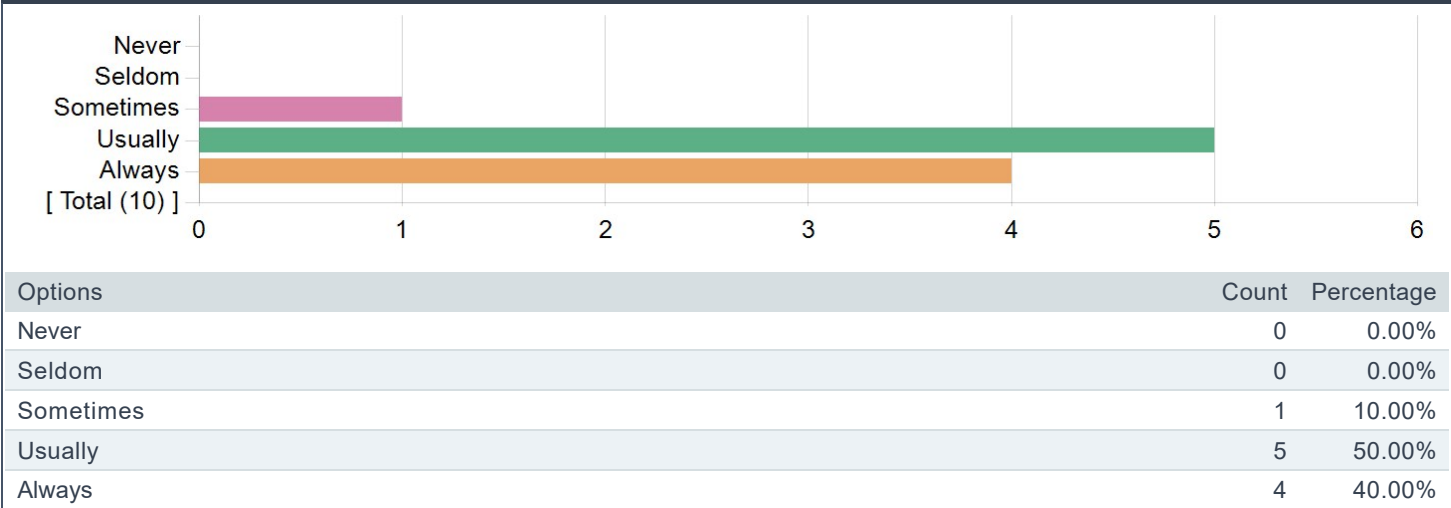

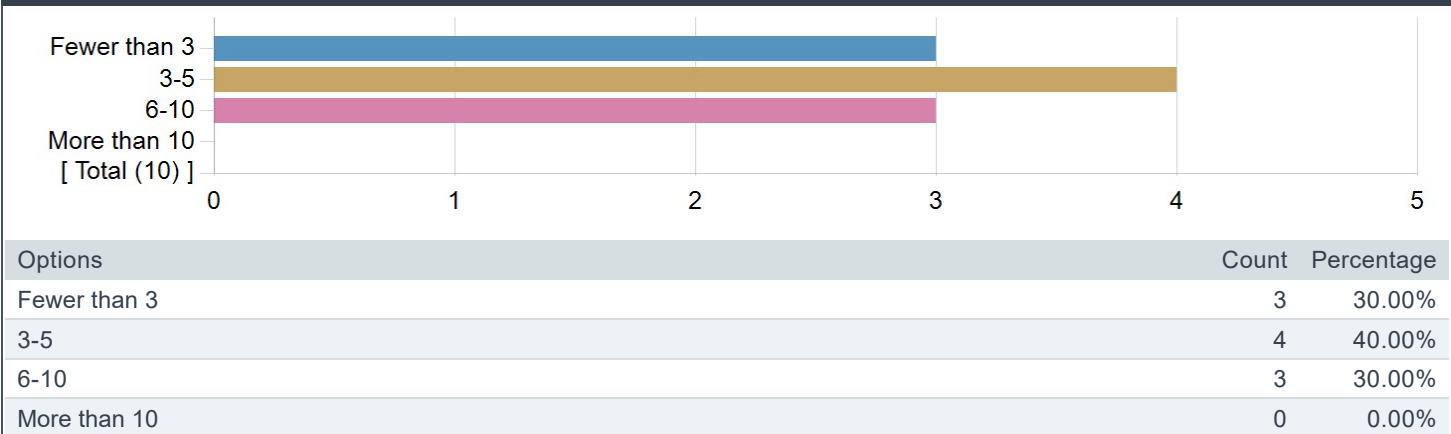

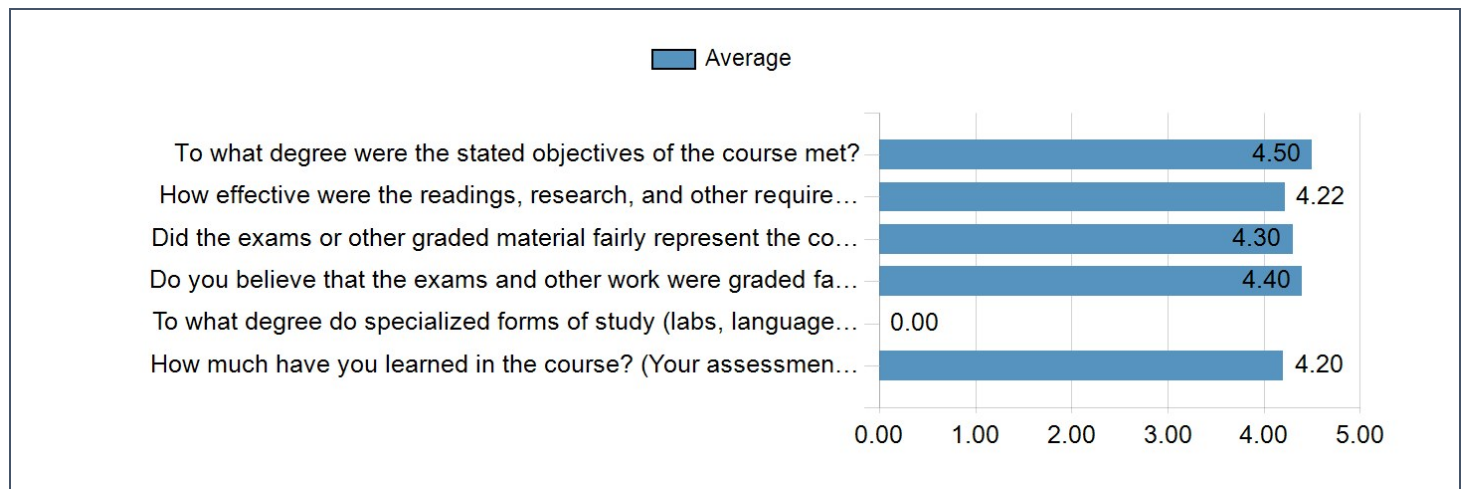

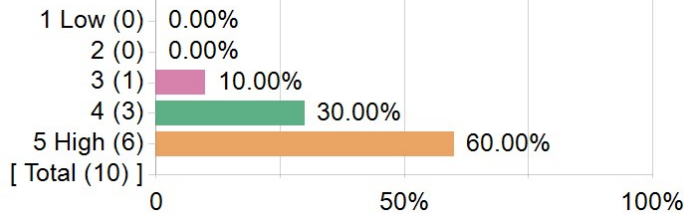

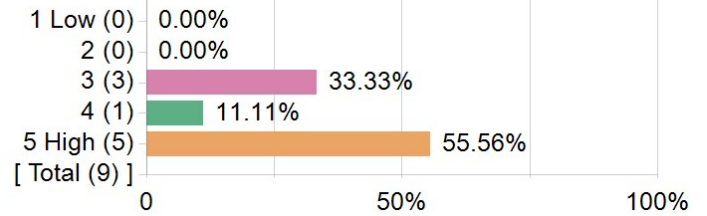

1. To what degree were the stated objectives of the course met?



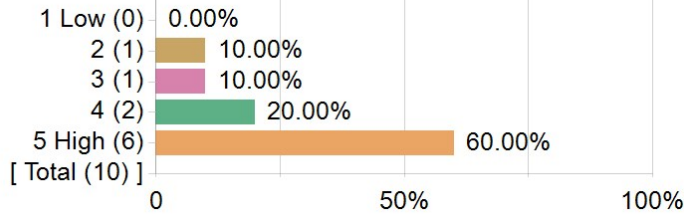

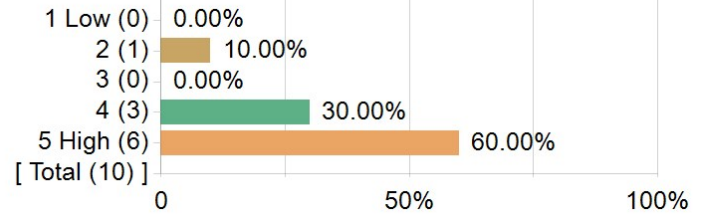

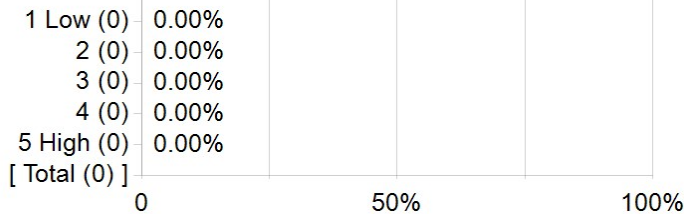

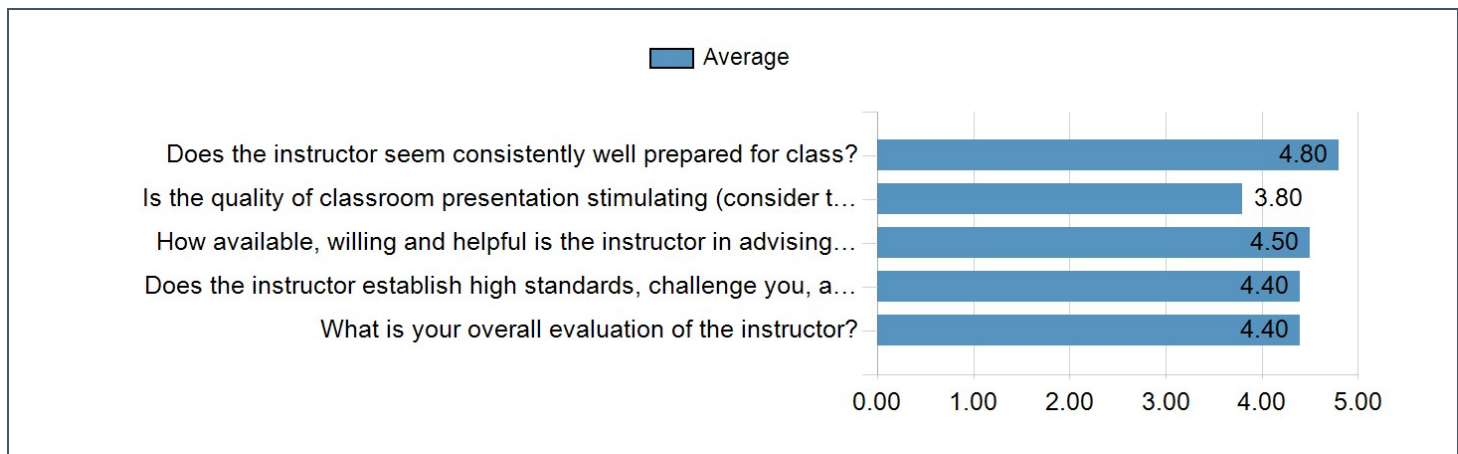

The pseudo code form that was used to explain problems was very helpful, but it was also hard to have concrete flows to follow as a reference, since the example code would be constantly modified. Hand drawn flow chart/examples from the instructor would have been superior the the work flows found in the book and on secondary slides.

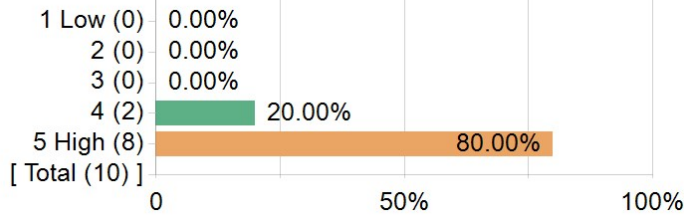

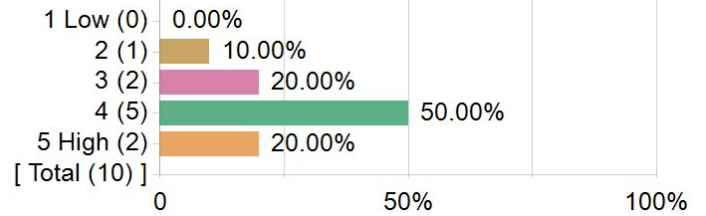

1. Does the instructor seem consistently well prepared for class?



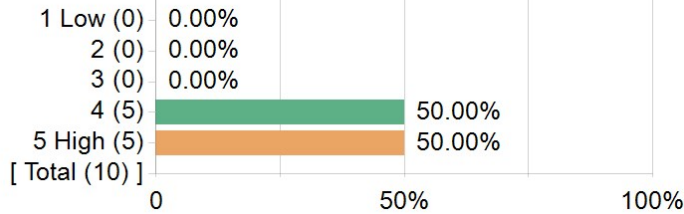

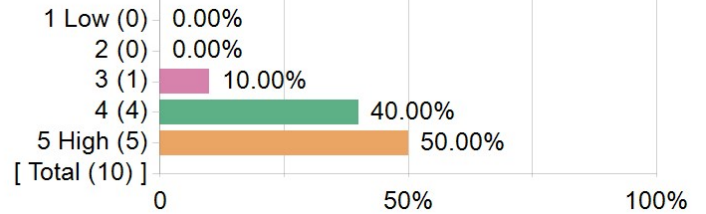

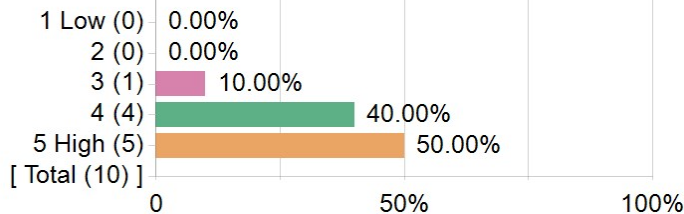
