

The course was of a good degree of rigor and wasn't too demanding as long as you attend all the lectures, but it covered a lot of ground, which I appreciate.


Homework problems are great preparation and good examples of the types of problems he expects us to be able to consider. More explicit textbook reading sections might be helpful.



I learned a lot about distributed systems and thinking of how servers and networks are designed. This course opened up an entirely new field I haven't explored before, which was really interesting.


All content was covered thoroughly, and exams were fair. You know the class is taught well when you blame yourself for missing exam questions rather than the prof's teaching.






Frequency Distribution




