Very structured lecture notes, lots of engagement when speaking, and very relevant homework.

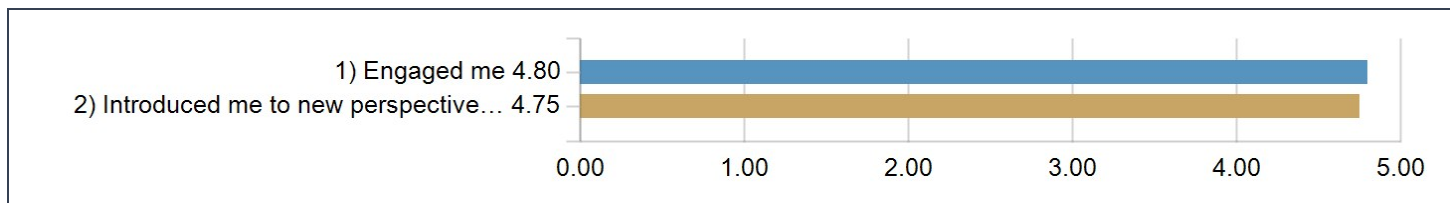
Do you have any specific recommendations for improving this course?

Idk, but to the registrar: please don't schedule a class at 8:00 AM in the Car Barn again :P

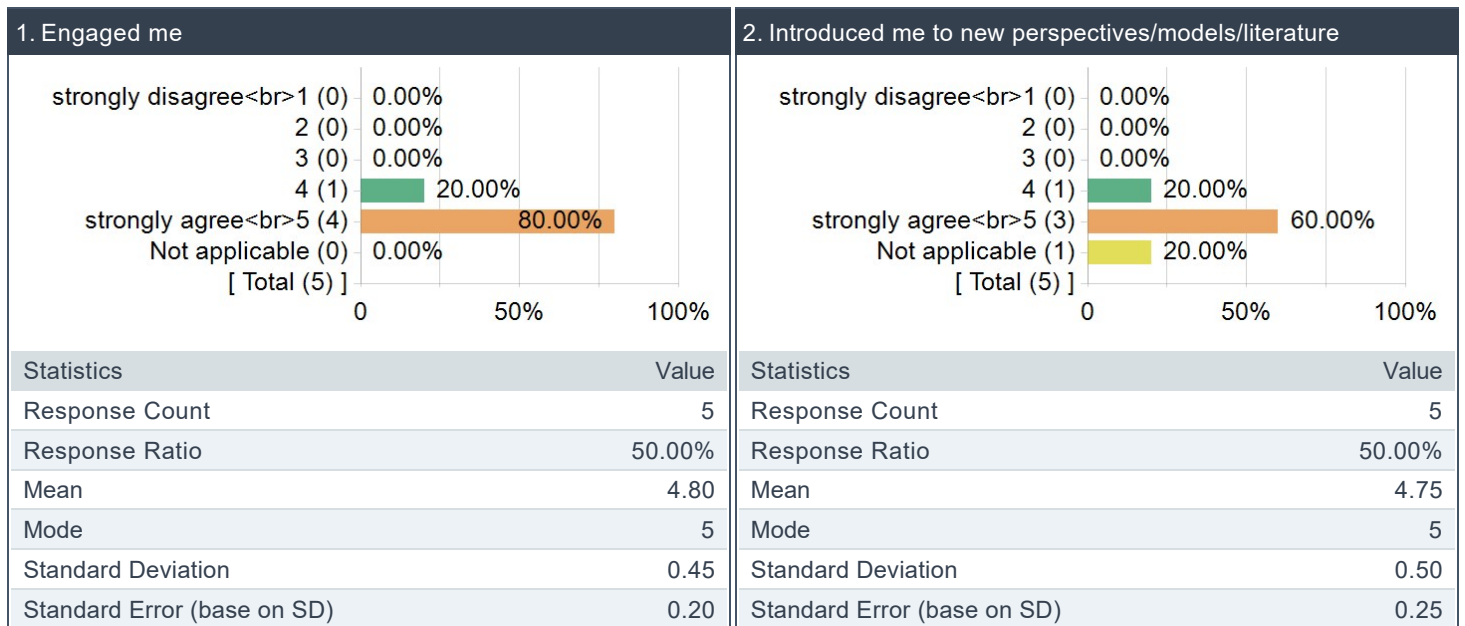

The first exam was graded a little overly harshly with minimal partial credit compared to the assignments and first exam.

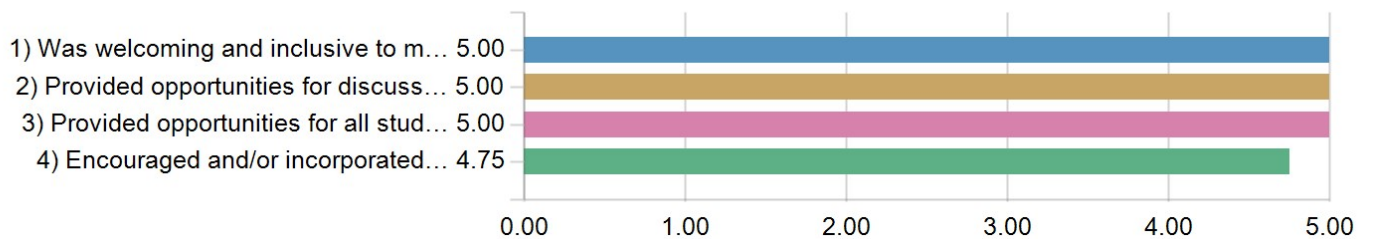
I only wish that I'd been more careful with the homework and gotten some more points!

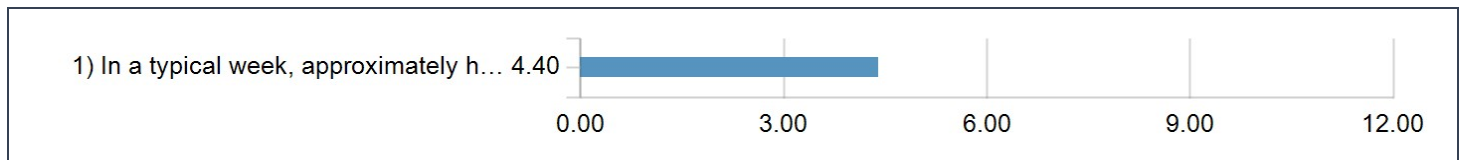
How often have you attended this class?

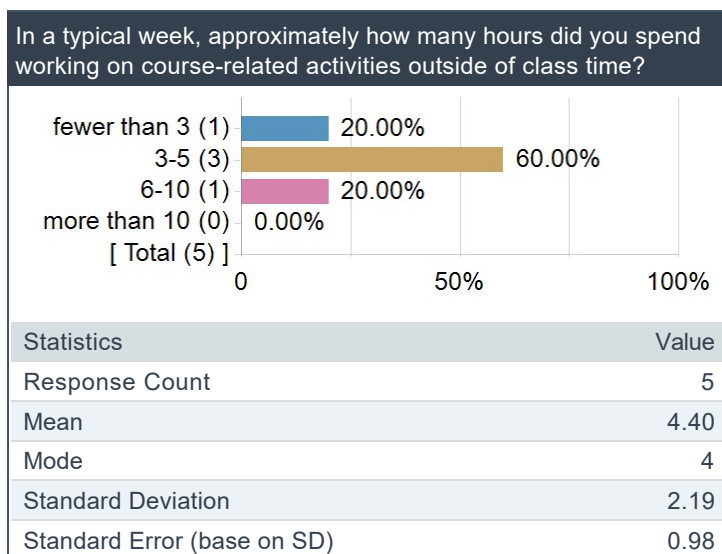
In a typical week, approximately how many hours did you spend working on course-related activities outside of class time?



